Paper: presentation guidelines

Format

1. Paper presentations are expected to be 15-20 minutes long to allow time for questions/ discussion in parallel sessions. Rooms will be set up with PC's or laptops and data projectors.

Contents

1. As a guideline we would expect papers to be between maximum 3000-4000 words as full text. Do bear in mind that we will be keeping verbal presentations to a timetable.
2. Please include your abstract, and name/ titles/ affiliations as well as an up to date biography (50-100 words).

Submission

1. Abstracts- Deadline : 1 October

We will use the abstract which you previously submitted in the conference booklet, unless you send an updated version. If your paper has been conditionally accepted, we expect submission of a revised abstract by 1 Oct.

2. Full papers- Deadline: 20 November

Please bring a digital copy (compatible with both Mac and PC) of your full paper and any image presentation (ideally in a pdf or powerpoint format) with you when you arrive at the conference in Edinburgh. We will then be able to set up parallel paper presentations in advance, and to undertake the initial reviewing of papers for publication.

Poster: presentation guidelines

Format

1. Full size A2 (420mm x 594mm) portrait
2. 150 - 300 dpi resolution. Please avoid resolution higher than 300 dpi since it will slow down the printing process.
3. Please submit your file as JPEG or PDF (JPEG is preferred, PDF is acceptable) and limit the file size to under 5MB.

Contents

1. There is no preferred poster layout, the A2 portrait paper is your only limit.
2. maximum 200-300 words of announcements/descriptions on the poster.
3. Please do not include your name/ titles etc on the poster: Labelling which includes author(s), institution, project/ poster title etc will be organized by us as part of the curation of the posters in the gallery.

Submission

1. Deadline: 1st of November. However, we encourage early submission so that your submission can be checked and acknowledged.
2. Email is preferred but if your file size has to be over 5mb, please make a copy on CD and send by post. Please reserve few days for delivery.
